<u>OH|ID Portal</u> - We know there are issues with OH|ID this morning. We got word a couple of hours ago that things were fixed, but are still receiving messages that all tiles are not appearing when logging in. That issue is still being addressed. Some users have indicated that if they go to the Profile App tile then apps return, but others don't have the Profile App available. ODE will keep working on this issue and send an update when fully resolved. We don't have a timeline - it is not an issue with SSDT or ODE, but with statewide implementation.

FY23 Collections and Reports - Three manifest updates are coming out later this week; the SOES End of Year (update); End of Year Student Collection (FY23); Graduation Collection (FY23). A new English Learner report is also coming out later this week, looking at the English Learner status reported for a student. This report will do a comparison of OELPA scores reported and the EL status reported in prior years to ensure students are moving through the sequence (L to S; S to N or Y) and pointing out inconsistencies. For example, if a district is reporting a student this year as an EL student, but last year's reporting indicated OELPA scores that should have exited the student, this will be pointed out on the report. It is important to get this information reported correctly for funding purposes. Encourage districts, even though it's late in the year, to review and confirm the students are being reported correctly. If a student did pass OELPA last year, the EL Status for this year should be updated to show they've exited. We also found a few cases where students were reported with an EL status last year and did not score enough on the OELPA to exit, but for some reason the district chose to exit them this year; there's a possibility the district is missing out on funds. There are a number of result codes on the report to provide information as to what may need to be reviewed or checked for each student on the report. We will be discussing this report in some more detail (along with other information) during the last session at OAEP.

<u>ODE EMIS Trainings</u> - EMIS Graduation Focused Trainings will take place on 5/17 and 5/19. These sessions are offered online; there is no need to pre-register. <u>OAEP Conference</u> - This will be taking place next week, May 7-9. Several ODE staff will be presenting at the conference.

<u>FY24 EMIS Changes</u> - We are continuing to work on EMIS changes for FY24. All policy changes should be out by Monday, May 15, 2023 (changes driven by budget and legislative changes will be out later).

Q&A

Q: Did you say there are 3 manifest updates coming out this week? You mentioned the EL report - are there others?

A: SOES End of Year (update) - will be version 4. End of Year Student - version 1, and Graduate Collection - version 1, will all be released on Thursday morning.

Q: I heard that CETE may be possibly releasing a file for WebXam the week of May 8th. Should we be using this file to report, or is this just for graduation and things of that sort? WebXam indicated they

would be releasing a preliminary file on May 8th to include all scores up through May 5th to be used by districts for graduation purposes. At the end of June, another file with all scores will be released. **A:** Go ahead and use that for reporting. The idea is students can potentially get college credit, and there are also re-testing possibilities on some exams for seniors, which there have not been previously, so they really want to get that stuff out there so districts can get it reported to see where students are at. That's the plan - to have a preliminary file and final file.

WebXam End-Of-Year Reporting Changes

Starting this school year, WebXam will provide preliminary End-of-Year data files to our ITC partners during the week of May 8, 2023. These files will include all test results for tests taken through May 5, 2023, including finalized field tests.

The final End-of-Year data files in Mid-June will supersede the preliminary files and include all data from them as well as any test data from May 8, 2023, to the end of the school year.
