RFI Evaluation Rubric I created a rubric to assign points based upon

meeting the outlined specifications. In addition, solutions would receive points for meeting the other aspects of the RFI; however, meeting the requirements of the specifications resulted in the

greatest number of points.

RFI Results As reported previously, we received a limited

response to the RFI. Three vendors have been involved in discussions with us including, Canvas,

CourseStorm, and PowerSchool.

Evaluation of Potential Solutions Canvas has a Course Catalog module; however,

you must load each of the courses in the Canvas LMS. Licensing Canvas LMS statewide is cost prohibitive. PowerSchool proposed using the professional development module under the Unified Talent umbrella of solutions. While this has potential, it too is cost prohibitive. After meeting with CourseStorm to clarify our requirements, created a sandbox to allow for

demonstration and testing.

BASA Technology Committee – This was a very informative session. All present engaged and offered insight, answers and provided questions for our consideration.

Review of Potential Solutions – I provided a brief demonstration of the CourseStorm solution. The consensus was that this solution had an updated interface and could be a platform for this project. We discussed the possibility of having a developer review the software developed by Chad Carson to see if an update to that solution might be a possible alternative.

Professional Development Discussion – the group discussed professional development needs for the project including; PD specific to the solution, general PD for teachers in a blended environment, as well as PD for parents with students participating in a class offered through the platform.

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How Do We Measure Success?

There was an acknowledgement that the following were measures of success: meeting project timelines and deliverables, school participation, student participation, number of courses in the catalog. This is an item that we will continue to discuss.

In addition, there was a suggestion to survey staff from the home school with a student participating in a course regarding the effectiveness of a course offered through the platform.

Two suggestions regarding schools participating in a course on the platform. The first was to create suggestions (or recommendations) regarding the course platform (Zoom, Teams, etc.). The second was to create suggestions for equipment needed to be successful in both the hosting school and the home school.
