FY22 EMIS Changes Posted for Public Comment — ODE has posted the first of the FY22 changes for public comment under SB89 requiring that we have a public comment period for each of the changes. If you go to the FY22 change page, you can see those changes highlighted with a note that a particular change is open for public comment. EMIS changes that are subject to this process must be posted on the website for 30 days for public comment, 30 days for the Department's response to comments, and then another 30 days for public review before changes are considered effective.

Each of the individual changes has the details of what will be changed in the EMIS guide and also has an individual email link that will allow you to send your comments with the subject line listing the change that pertains to. There will be additional batches released in the coming weeks and months as ODE works through the FY22 changes that are under this provision of the law. We will talk more about these changes on the upcoming Change Call, which is Wednesday, April 14<sup>th</sup>.

<u>NEW EMIS Coordinator sessions</u> – The sessions will start next week. While they are called New EMIS Coordinator, anyone from the district that is interested in those topics are welcome to attend. They are switching them to different type of meeting to allow more to attend. Each are on a particular topic and will last about 2 hours.

<u>March D Follow-Up</u> – Closes April 16<sup>th</sup>. ODE is sending out reminders for those who have not yet submitted. There are a fair amount of LEAs that have not submitted yet.

**Q:** You mentioned the new EMIS changes and the public comment. What are the change numbers?

**A:** It's a whole list of changes that were in the NEWSFLASH. Also, if you go to the EMIS Change page, the ones that are in public comment, those should be in **red**.

**Q:** Is the vendor call on for this week?

**A:** Yes it is Thursday this week.

**Q:** Can you tell us anything more about the email Teresa Williams sent out this morning about ODDEX?

**A:** one of the things we have heard is this person is no longer at my district, why are they still showing up as a user? ODE has now initiated a process that will indicate if anyone has had there privileges revoked for your district. Also, ODE wants everyone to update their profile to make sure everything is current and cleaned up.
