## **ODE EMIS Conference Call Summary**

**EMIS Changes** – Some EMIS changes have been moved to FY23 due to legislative changes.

**23-21 – Align CORE Area Options and Subject Area for Credit Options** – Several CORE area codes were added for FY22 that were not also added to the Subject Area for Credit element because of the timelines laid out in the 90-day process that's laid out in SB89 now in ORC. ODE cannot put forth any additional FY22 changes that are not driven by a legislative change. So those codes cannot be added for FY22. They will be added to the FY23 Manual.

**23-19 FY23 CTE Program Matrix Changes** – There are five new subject codes, name modification, deletions of some codes, additional programs of concentration, and additional assessment area codes. Public comment closes December 10<sup>th,</sup> although these are FY23 changes.

**Q:** Are those the same codes on the 23-21 change that David did at the OEDSA Conference?

A: Yes, they are

<u>Five Year Forecast</u> – Districts have until the end of November to get that submitted. Encourage districts to get those submitted before the Thanksgiving break. The window closes on November 30<sup>th</sup>.

<u>FY22 Student Collection</u> – Both the Traditional (1TRD) and Community School (AODE) Initial Student collections are closing on December 20, 2021. Some data will be finalized at that time (e.g., Casino Count, Federal Child Count, and some withdrawal information for CTE March Follow-up reporting). Encourage districts to submit these collections, so they have time to ensure everything is correct before then.

<u>New Data Collector</u> – This should be out before our next call in 2 weeks. ODE has wrapped up their testing and will load some data into driver tables this week and early next week. The ESP Solutions group will reach out to Tech contacts at the ITCs. There is no special deadline for ITCs to install this, but ODE will start talking about the new features soon. This update should help with several things going on in the background, which you probably don't see day to day, but should improve reliability and performance.
